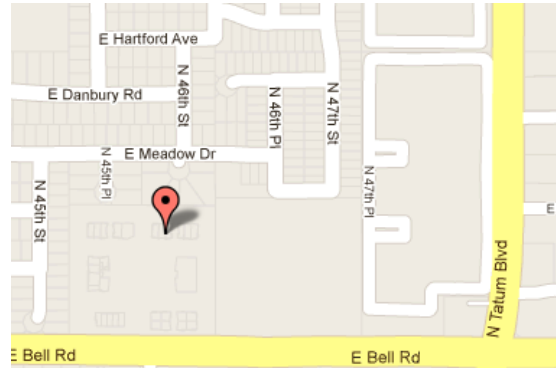


Benefits of Compass Services

Crisis Services

Compass Mental Health provides emergent mental health and substance abuse services for patients being treated in hospitals and medical practices throughout Arizona. Services may include screening, assessment, risk analysis, crisis intervention and counseling, de-escalation, critical incident debriefing, and consultation. Depending on the situation, Compass may also assist in the coordination of patient transfers to a more appropriate facility for specialized care (e.g. behavioral health hospital or detox center). Compass also provides follow up and aftercare services for all patients to ensure their needs are met post intervention.

What constitutes a Mental Health Crisis?

An emergency psychological condition exists when a person's health and safety are at risk, or when the person is at risk of harming others, as a result of their mental condition. Medical necessity in psychological terms means that the person may be experiencing any of the following:

- ◆ Altered mental status
- ◆ Psychosis
- ◆ Intoxication
- ◆ Is a danger to self or others (suicidal or homicidal ideations alone are enough to consider a person as having an emergent psychological condition, the person does not need to express a plan, means or intent)

Protocols for the Medical Practice

Contact Compass at (602) 633-6222 for any medically stable patient presenting with an emergent psychological condition. Compass will provide psychological evaluation, intervention and stabilization services, including:

- ◆ Risk and mental status assessments
- ◆ Crisis intervention and screening
- ◆ Clinical needs assessments
- ◆ Coordination of care for patients needing transfer to a higher level of care
- ◆ Follow up and aftercare services for all our patients to ensure the patient's needs are met post intervention
